For this purpose the New Zealand Automobile Association (AA) includes itself and any division, subsidiary, third party under contract, or joint venture companies including AA Financial Services and AA Insurance.

AA Membership Terms and Conditions

AA Membership

AA Membership is non-refundable, non-transferable and personal to the Member.

AA Members are eligible for loyalty discounts once they have been a Member of the AA for more than one year and provided there is no break in Membership.

Membership entitlements do not cover pre-existing incidents or breakdowns that occurred prior to the Member joining the AA.

The AA reserves the right to deny services to any Member who in the AA's opinion is or has been abusive, threatening or violent toward any AA staff, or who attempts or has attempted to receive service by deception, with no requirement to refund.

Callouts

Roadservice callouts are restricted to six free callouts per year, however Members with 10 or more years continuous AA Membership are entitled to unlimited callouts. Callouts in excess of the free annual limit will be charged at \$60 (including GST) per callout.

In the event of a vehicle callout, the Member must remain with the vehicle and be able to produce their AA Membership card plus another form of identification acceptable to the AA, such as a driver's licence, when the callout is attended.

Lost Keys

Where a Member has lost their car key and requires the services of a locksmith, the AA's maximum contribution is \$40 for urban areas and \$100 for other areas. If a Member has AA Plus or AA Motorhome Plus the AA's maximum contribution is \$150. This applies to labour content only.

Towing a vehicle to repair or safety after a breakdown

If the vehicle the Member is in breaks down or has a mechanical problem that cannot be repaired on the spot, the AA will tow the vehicle to the nearest place of safety or repair where arrangements for its repair can be made or where it can be safely stored. (Storage costs will be at the Member's cost). There is no charge to the Member for this callout and/or towing charges unless requiring/requesting towage to a location which is more than 10km distant (top up fees may apply.) Once a tow has been provided for a breakdown, any subsequent tows for the same breakdown will be paid for by the Member at the time of service. This includes towing a vehicle that has been towed after hours to the Member's home, a storage area, or other place of repair or safety, and then needs further towing as a consequence of the same breakdown event.

Specialist vehicles and motorcycles

Towing or recovery of vehicles that have been lowered or modified or are fitted with body kits will be on a best endeavours basis and may be subject to delays due to availability of suitable contractors. Any additional charges/costs for specialised recovery equipment or labour will be at the Member's expense. The AA will provide vehicle recovery for motorcycles on a best endeavours basis and may be subject to availability of suitable contractors. If the Member chooses not to accept the attending tow truck, any other arrangements will be at the Member's expense.

Additional transportation

Carriage of passengers or anything on-tow at the time of the breakdown can only be to the legal limit of the attending vehicle. Any expense as a result of additional transportation or a return journey to pick up extra passengers/vehicles is at the Member's cost.

On-tow caravan/trailer limits

If an on-tow vehicle breaks down, the AA will recover it to the nearest place of repair or safety, to a maximum contribution of \$40 in urban areas and \$100 in other areas. All on-tow vehicles must comply with Land Transport New Zealand size and weight regulations. Livestock are the full responsibility of the Member and must be secured by the Member before attendance.

Incorrectly fuelled

Where Roadservice is required as a result of a vehicle being fuelled with the wrong type of fuel, then a tow will be organised to the nearest place of repair or safety, if a specialised fuel recovery contractor is not available. Any specialised fuel recovery, further towing and repair will be at the Member's expense.

Mobility scooters

Where a Mobility Scooter becomes immobile due to a flat battery, flat tyre or lost keys, the AA will provide vehicle recovery to the Member's home address, so long as no nursing, lifting of the Member or other special personal assistance is needed. Carriage of passengers can only be to the legal limit of the attending vehicle. If alternative transport for the Member is required, this will be at the Member's expense.

AA Membership exclusions

Service cannot be provided if:

- > the Member joined the AA within the last 24 hours
- > the vehicle is over 3½ tonnes gross laden weight
- > the vehicle is unattended by the Member at the time that it breaks down and when roadside assistance is provided
- > the vehicle is not on public or formed roads, or trapped/ bogged
- > the vehicle is involved in or disabled due to a motor vehicle accident, or stolen, or damaged due to theft or vandalism
- > the vehicle is unregistered and/or unwarranted
- > the vehicle is more than 2.44 metres wide overall, more than 3 metres high overall and/or more than 7 metres long overall (Please note: recovery of vehicles exceeding 5.5 metres overall length may be subject to delays from some locations due to the unavailability of a suitable recovery vehicle).
- > the vehicle is un-roadworthy/unsafe, or it would be dangerous or illegal for the AA representative to repair, load or transport the vehicle and/or its occupants
- > the Member poses a safety risk to other motorists in the opinion of the AA representative
- > the vehicle is carrying any form of hazardous materials
- > the vehicle is immobilised due to failure to carry a serviceable spare wheel and wheel changing equipment suitable to the vehicle
- > the vehicle was being used for racing, pacemaking, speed testing, reliability trials, competitions or off-road activities at the time of the breakdown
- > the vehicle is carrying a load beyond the legal limit

The Member is not covered for

- > vehicle parts/fuel/repairs on garage/repairer premises
- > breakdowns which are covered under insurance policies
- > problems relating to electrical items within the vehicle e.g. radio/CD players, fridges
