

## Learn to drive the AA Way

### Test Day Checklist

On the day of your test it's a good idea to arrive 30 minutes early and you must:

- bring your current driver licence. If you are using your current temporary licence, you also need to bring photographic ID, such as an 18+ card, student ID card, or current passport
- Completed application form (form DL1) and payment
- make sure the vehicle being used for the test has:
  - a current Warrant of Fitness (WoF)
  - a current vehicle licence (registration)
  - a current road user charges (RUC) licence (if you are driving a diesel car)
  - approved L-plates displayed front and rear if you are on a learner licence
- get someone to help you to do a pre-drive check of the vehicle you'll be using for the test to make sure it's in good working order
- make sure you know how to get to where your test will start
- check that your vehicle has enough fuel to get there, complete the test and get back home
- wear your correcting lenses, if you need to, when driving
- make sure you give yourself enough time to get to the test location on time for the test (if you arrive late, your test will be cancelled and you'll need to book another time and pay another fee)
- ensure the passenger seat is clean and tidy for the testing officer to sit on

If you don't comply with any of the points above, the testing officer won't be able to take you for your test and may need to book and pay for another test.

**Important:** If you are on a learner licence, you need to be accompanied to the test site by a supervisor, as you are not legally allowed to drive solo.
