



Application for International Driving Permit

Heading overseas and looking to drive? Apply for an International Driving Permit (IDP).

What is an IDP?

An IDP is a translation of your current New Zealand driver licence, to help overseas authorities understand your licence.

An IDP is not a licence on its own, you must carry your New Zealand driver licence with it when you drive overseas. IDP acceptance and conditions can vary by country – check with the local licensing authority before you travel.

 - the IDP Terms of Sale
- The IDP we issue is under the 1949 United Nations Convention on Road Traffic. This IDP is not accepted in all countries. A list of excluded countries is published on our AA website but this can change at short notice. We recommend you contact your destination's embassy or consulate to confirm you can use an IDP for the purposes you intend. You are responsible for making your own enquiries about whether this IDP will be accepted in your destination(s) and for the purposes you wish to use it.
- An IDP cannot be used for commercial purposes.

What you need - You must bring the following **original** documents

○ Your current Full New Zealand Driver Licence

Following licences are not accepted: • Learner • Restricted • Temporary Licence • Alcohol Interlock • Supervisor condition • Limited Licence

○ Recent passport size photograph

– this can be taken at any AA Driver Licensing outlets (at an additional charge)

○ Payment for IDP application (EFTPOS, credit card or cash)

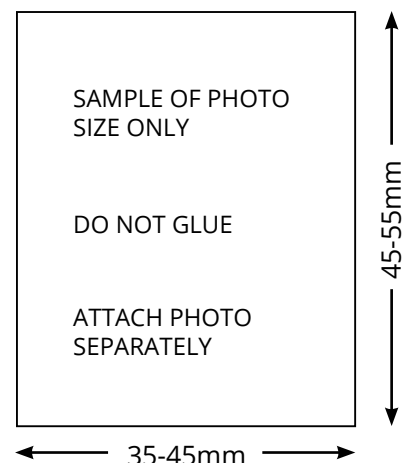
What you need - Your photo must meet the following requirements:

Size: 35 x 45mm min, 45 x 55mm max, and on good quality photo paper

Full front view of face, head and shoulders only

Head must fill photo and must be a good likeness of you

Have a plain, light coloured background - Photo can be black and white or coloured
