## Roadworthiness is a concern

**62%**



are concerned about **vehicle condition** on NZ roads

## WoFs are a key safety backstop




**59%**  
rely on WoFs to identify safety issues




**42%**

## Vehicle maintenance between WoFs is inconsistent



**26%** do not check tyres between WoFs




**4%** drove with worn tyres in the past 4 weeks

## Some drive with unsafe vehicles

## Costs and forgetting contribute to non-compliance



**24%** have **forgotten** their WoF is due



**10%** have delayed a WoF due to **cost**


## Mixed opinions on increasing WoFs from 6 to 12 months

## About the AA Vehicle Safety Survey

Data taken from the AA Vehicle Safety Survey, conducted in November 2025. The survey response rate was 55% (n=2,068 out of 3,821 Members invited). The margin of error is 1% at the 95% confidence interval. Results are weighted to reflect the demographics of the AA Membership.
