The Trailer Safety course spans a full day and is conducted at various locations across the country. Participants are required to finish a brief online theory course before engaging in the practical learning segment of the course.

The online theory component of the course covers:

- Light trailer safety and handling theory
- Legal requirements
- Safety techniques
- Videos for hitching/unhitching, loading/unloading and reversing

Light Trailer Safety and Handling Module: Braking Requirements (Optional): For those with trailers equipped with brakes, an additional optional module (approximately 30 minutes) is available, focusing on braking requirements.

The course is suitable for:

- ✓ Advanced training and new ideas for anyone who drives with a trailer
- ✓ Anyone who isn't confident or nervous with manoeuvring trailer
- ✓ Anyone who has been involved in a trailer-related incident

Practical Training

The practical training session is held over the course a full day at a suitable closed road site. Clients must provide suitable vehicles & a trailer for the practical training session.

Hitching and Unhitching

Proper procedures for connecting and disconnecting trailers

✓ Slalom (Cones)

Maneuvering through a slalom course to enhance control and handling skills

✓ Forward Parking (right and left angle)

Safe and precise forwarding parking at a right and left angle.

✓ Reverse Parking (straight line and right angle)

Backing up and parking in straight line and right angle.

✓ Spatial Awareness

Testing spatial awareness and precision in tight spaces

Advanced Task: Reverse Arc*

An advanced exercise assessing the participants readiness for complex maneuvers

✓ Advanced Task: Reverse Slalom*

A challenging task to test advanced reversing skills

✓ Assessment Drive (optional)

A 15 minute on road assessment drive to evaluate the participants overall proficiency in trailer handling.

*The tutor will assess individual/group experience and skills to determine suitability for the advanced sessions

Booking a Course

The AA can support training courses at a number of locations around New Zealand. All courses are client specific, and our team will work with you to find an suitable date and location for the training.

At the time of booking please provide us with:

- Name of all participants
- Email address of all participants
- Vehicle make, model and registration for all participants
- Details of the trailer(s) to be used for the training
- Details of anyone sharing vehicles on the day

Cost:

Individuals - \$400 + GST

Please note, there is a minimum requirement of 4 participants per course

Travel expenses will be incurred for some areas of the North and South Island. If travel expenses are payable you will be advised at the time of booking.

The course fee excludes the rental cost of the venue & cones (if required)

Cancellations
