This Factsheet tells you what is included in our Defensive Driving Plus course and how it will benefit your business. It also tells you the price and how you can book.

Experienced drivers can often become complacent over time. Our Defensive Driving Plus course teaches drivers how driving defensively can help them to avoid finding themselves in a crash situation. We then teach the practical vehicle control skills to remain in control of the vehicle, should the worst happen.

What's included:

This full day session is held at our purpose built sites in Auckland and Wellington. The day is a 50/50 split between theory and a practical session and includes a light lunch and refreshments.

The theory component of the course includes the essential principles for being a safer company driver:

- Risk management
- Searching and scanning techniques
- Identification and response to hazards
- Vehicle handling and coping strategies
- Economical driving techniques
- Law changes
- Updated driving procedures.
- Managing fatigue, stress and emotion while driving
- How to deal with and avoid road rage incidents
- The relationship between alcohol/drugs and driving

The practical workshops teach the following advanced driving skills:

- How to make a safe and controlled emergency stop
- Safe cornering
- The value and function of the anti-lock braking systems (ABS) and electronic stability control (ESC)
- Participants' driving limitations and that of their vehicles

The day is designed to be fun and fast paced with a focus on safety rather than speed.
